

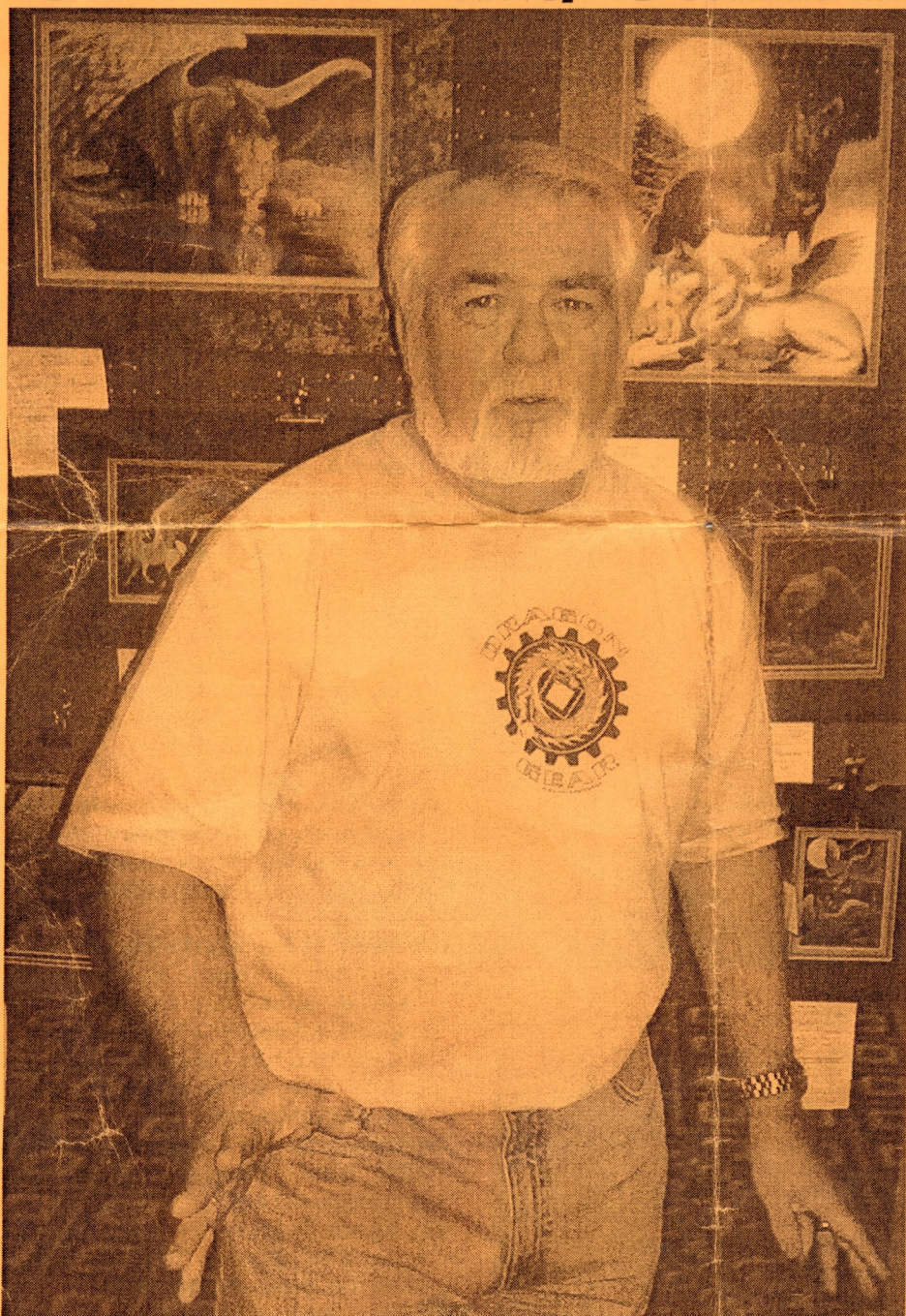

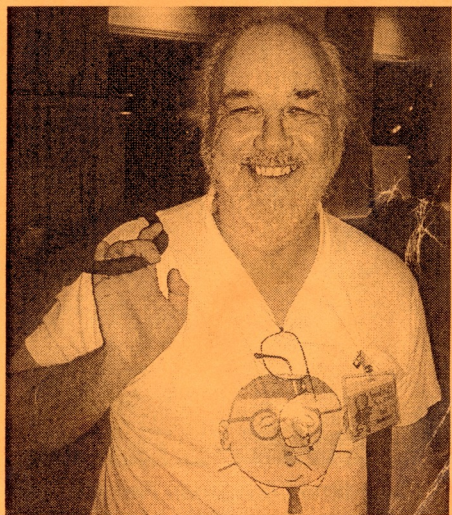

SF Conventions Back in Las Vegas

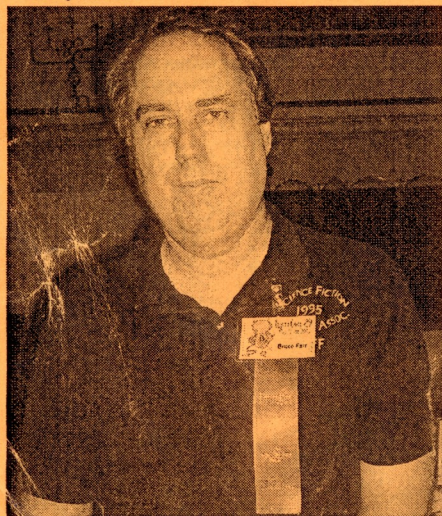
