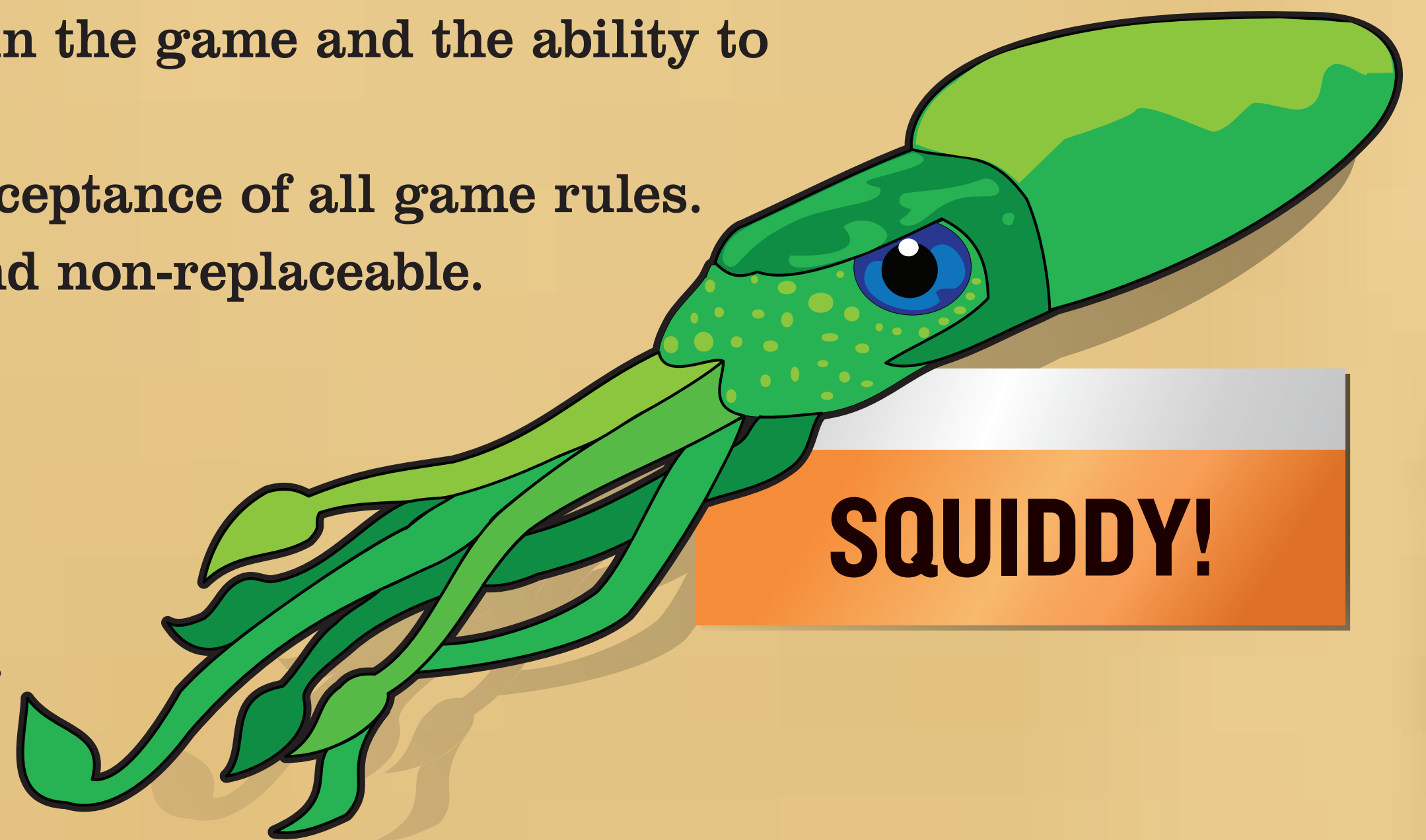
RULES & INFORMATION

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- This Game is a fundraiser and is a fun activity taking place Friday-Sunday.
- **Each Ribbon is \$5.**
- All proceeds go to **Kids Need To Read** a non-profit literacy program.
- The purchase of ribbon allows participation in the game and the ability to challenge for a Squiddy as per the rules.
- The purchase of the Ribbon also indicates acceptance of all game rules.
- All Squiddy purchases are non-refundable and non-replaceable.

RULES:

- A **displayed ribbon** (attached to Pass) is an indication of **participation**.
- Squiddies are the stakes in a **challenge**.



Challenges consist of:

1. A verbal challenge, Example: **“I challenge you for your Squiddy!”**
2. Discuss **Terms and Stakes** (for this challenge only). Both participants must agree to the terms of the squiddy challenge.
Example: 3 squiddy in a single game. Or 5 squiddy in best two out of three.
Or extra/substitute hand signals... Be creative.

2. Play Game of Roshambo (Rock Paper Scissors), the **winner** gets the prize(s).

- One on one duels only. A person who is challenged may indicate a Second/Champion to play the game on their behalf, but the stakes remain theirs.
- All participants may issue or be challenged, and must play if challenged.
- Please do not interrupt any Event, Panel, Workshop, etc. to issue a challenge.
- At the beginning of the game, or if you lose all your squiddies, the ribbon will indicate your ability to challenge other participants for a single squiddy.
- Squiddies must be kept within sight(available as stakes) and with the player at all times.
- No stashing your pile of squiddies in a bag or your car or permanently attaching them to a costume.

Rules adherence and participant disputes will be mediated by Guest Services.

- Any Guest Services staff member may act as referee if needed.
- Appeals go to the next highest level of Staff.
- The Guest Services Coordinator will have final judgement on all aspects of game play. No further appeals.
- Challenges are allowed inside Rusted Gear (Old Tucson) and it's outlying areas, however; Guest Services will not mediate issues that arise outside of the park.

VICTORY!

The person with **the most squiddies** at the end of the weekend (5pm Sunday at the Convention Wrap-up) will receive a **Special Prize**.
You must be in attendance at time of award to receive prize.
