

Christy Lijewski's big break was Tokyopop's Rising Stars of Manga contest, in which her entry, Doors, placed runner up. She has done Next Exit for Slave Labor Graphics & is currently publishing RE:Play for Tokyopop.

MIKE MANLEY

His powerful and expressive drawings, dynamic inks and strong story telling skills, have made him an in-demand artist for some of comic's top titles for all of the major publishers from Marvel, DC to Dark Horse. Manley has also done animation work on Superman, Batman and Batman Beyond for WB.

MIKE MAYHEW

Mayhew started out at DC in 1992, but gained recognition as the artist on Topp's Comics Zorro series & on Vampirella for Harris Publications. He has continued developing his ultra-realistic painting skills with covers for titles like Mystique, She-Hulk, and this year's PCC guide.

His hauntingly beatiful covers on Marvel titles New Mutants, X-Men Unlimited, and Runaways earned Middleton an Eisner nomination. Currently signed with DC, his work can be found on the Superman/Shazam: First Thunder miniseries.

Mychaels has provided pencils for a variety of titles including Brigade, Demonslayer, and X-Force: Shatterstar. He currently works as a graphic designer and freelance comic illustrator.

Known as "The Original Lois Lane," Neill acted in more than 40 films before starring in the 1948 and 1950 Superman movie serials with Kirk Alyn and opposite George Reeves on The Adventures of Superman TV show. Currently, she is promoting her biography, Truth Justisctce and the American Way: The Life & Times Of Noel Neill, The Original Lois Lane

STEVE NILES

As a writer with titles like 30 Days of Night, The Nail, Criminal Macabre, and Bad Planet under his belt, Niles is one of the writers responsible for bringing horror comics back to prominince. Recently, he and Thomas Jane formed the production company Raw Entertainment.

JIMMY PALMIOTTI
