

MATHEW ATHERTON (FEEDBACK)

Mathew, a fan of Spider-Man since the age of five, realized his dream last summer when he participated in SCI FI Channel's new reality TV show. Not only did he develop a personal relationship with Spider-Man's creator, but he became Stan Lee's next great superhero, Feedback, as the winner of Who Wants To Be A Superhero? In his secret identity, Mathew works as a software engineer and lives in Rancho Cucamonga, California, with his wife, Sarah, and two dogs, Emily and Maggie. The Feedback comic bo ok is slated to be published in January by Dark Horse Comics.

DAVE BEATY

Dave Beaty got his start in 1992 as a background artist on Guardians of the Galaxy (Marvel Comics). Since then, he's been professionally published as an inker, a penciller and a writer. He is the co-creator of Stargodz (Antarctic Press). He currently writes and draws the award-winning series Captain Value and Bushi Tales.

DEREK BENZ

Derek joined with his childhood friend, J.S. Lewis, to pen the acclaimed new series of *Grey Griffins* books (*The Revenge of the Shadow King* and *The Rise of the Black Wolf*), published by Scholastic, Inc. With twists and turns on every page, the series has captivated readers with tales steeped in archaeology, linguistics, mythology and cosmology.

CHRISTIAN BERANEK

Christian Beranek is a co-creator of the wildly successful graphic novel *Dracula vs. King Arthur.* His upcoming work includes *Venice Is Sinking, Unhappy White Girls, Silent Devils: Ja-Tan* and a project with Universal Music.

MIKE BULLOCK

His first creator-owned title, an all-ages story called *Lions, Tigers & Bears*, took the industry by storm and won critical acclaim. Bullock recently began writing for Moonstone Books' new *The Phantom* series and created *The Gimoles*, which is published by Image.

CHANNON DENTON

Denton is a veteran storyteller and artist who contributed to almost every action adventure show produced by Fox Kids Network. He has also worked for Nickelodeon and Cartoon Network. His projects have ranged from *Superman* to *Spawn* to *Star Wars*. Denton co-founded Komikwerks, which publishes the work of professional artists of animation, video games, comics and live action. He has books out from TokyoPop, Arcana and Image.

TAY FOTOS

Jay Fotos began work as a colorist for Todd McFarlane Productions in 1998. Since then, he has worked on Curse of the Spawn, Spawn: The Dark Ages, Spawn: The Undead, Sam and Twitch and Cy-Gor. Currently, Fotos is working on Death Dealer from Image Comics, Clive Barker's The Great and Secret Show, 30 Days of Night: Spreading the Disease and '68.

TESS FOWLER

Tess Fowler is a jack-of-all-trades when it comes to art. Her most recent work is included in the exciting Hellboy: Animated Storm of Swords sketch card project from Inkworks. This follows the Lord of the Rings: Masterpieces cards from Topps. A collection of her paintings will appear in the March, 2007 issue of Heavy Metal Magazine.

CRISPIN FREEMAN

Crispin got his start playing Zelgadis Graywords in The Slayers. He's also played Alucard in Hellsing, Balmung in .hack//SIGN, Amon in Witch Hunter Robin, Fuma Monou in X, Iketani (Cole) in Initial D, Rosiel in Angel Sanctuary, Saotome in Boogiepop Phantom, Alex Rowe in Last Exile, Tsume in Wolf's Rain, Togusa in Ghost in the Shell: S.A.C. and many more!

TIFFANY GRANT

Best known as Asuka from Neon Genesis Evangelion, Tiffany has voiced characters in well over 800 TV episodes, OVAs and movies including Satella in Chrono Crusade and Kaorin in Azumanga Daioh. She has also written the English dubbing scripts for TV series Angelic Layer, Maburaho and Comic Party Revolution. Tiffany's talent even extends to live action: she appeared in the movie Arlington Road, starring Jeff Bridges.

MATT GREENFIELD

Co-founder of ADV Films (A.D. Vision, Inc.), Matt currently serves as the vice-president in charge of production. As a writer, producer and director Greenfield has helmed well over 475 TV episodes and feature films including such fan favorites as RahX-ephon and the legendary Neon Genesis Evangelion. Matt's recent and current projects include Chrono Crusade, Gantz and the iconic Macross. As a voice actor, Matt's best-known roles are Hyuga in Neon Genesis Evangelion and Sugishita in Blue Seed.

ANY REEDER HADLEY

Hadley was a runner-up in Tokyopop's annual *Rising Stars of Manga* talent contest. Her relationship with the American manga publisher blossomed into *Fool's Gold*. Armed with an abundance of talent and a degree in social science, Hadley's debut work shows a grasp of the highs and lows of high school drama.

PHIL HESTER

In the last 15 years, Phil has worked for nearly every comic book publisher and is nearing his 300th published comic. His past

work includes: Swamp Thing, Detective, The Creeper, Ultimate Marvel Team-Up, Brave Old World, Namor and lots more. His current and upcoming work is as follows: Green Arrow, Firebreather and The Operation. He is nice and likes nice people.

ANDY KUHN

Andy is currently the artist on Marvel Team-Up and is working on future projects for DC Comics. His past credits include runs on Batgirl, Marvel Adventures, Spider-Man Unlimited and X-Men Adventures. Phil Hester and he co-created Firebreather, which was published by Image and optioned by Paramount Pictures for a feature film.

JON S. LEWIS

J.S. Lewis teamed with childhood friend, Derek Benz. Together, the duo collaborated to pen the acclaimed new series *Grey Griffins Books (The Revenge of the Shadow King* and *The Rise of the Black Wolf*), published by Scholastic, Inc. With twists and turns on every page, the series has captivated readers with tales steeped in archaeology, linguistics, mythology and cosmology.

ROB LIEFELD

One of the creators behind *Onslaught Reborn* (with Jeph Loeb), *Youngblood*, *X-Force* and New Mutants will be at PCC to meet with fans all day on Saturday. Our thanks go to Jimmy Jay and Jay Company Comics for helping to make Rob's appearance possible.

JEFF MARIOTTE

Jeff Mariotte has written more than 30 novels, including original supernatural thriller Missing White Girl, horror epic The Slab and YA horror quartet Witch Season. His tie-in books include the series Buffy the Vampire Slayer, Angel, Las Vegas, Conan, 30 Days of Night, Charmed, Star Trek and Andromeda. He is also the author of more comic books than he has time to count, including the original Western series Desperadoes.

ANGEL MEDINA

Angel had runs on The Incredible Hulk, Warlock and the Infinity Watch and The Avengers. Later, he joined Image Comics with Todd McFarlane, where he was the artist for Sam and Twitch. He eventually focused on Spawn, which he has now drawn for several years. In 2005, he was assigned to Marvel Knights Spider-Man at Marvel.

MIKE MIGNOLA

Mignola attracted great notice after his initial work for DC Comics. He had several high-profile assignments in 1988, including creating covers for Batman: A Death in the Family and penciling Cosmic Odyssey and Gotham

by Gaslight. In 1994, he deviated from the practice of only working on characters and properties of others; Mignola's first Hellboy story was published by Dark Horse Comics. The series about a paranormal investigator from Hell, the eponymous Hellboy, soon proved to be a popular and critical success. The storylines heavily draw on Mignola's own interests — folklore, monsters, B-movies, ghost stories and pulp stories. It has since become the endeavor with which Mignola is most closely connected, and he has kept up a steady stream of Hellboy stories and merchandise.

VIC MICHOCHA

Vic is a professional music composer/producer and veteran actor with ADV Films. He has most recently voiced characters in anime series as Edward Elric in Fullmetal Alchemist, Kurz in Full Metal Panic, Kougaji in Saiyuki and Mamoru in RahXephon. Vic has also voiced characters in Noir, Steel Angel Karumi, Orphen, Excel Saga, Yu Yu Hakusho, Kino's Journey, Dragonball GT and many others.

BRIAN MILLER/HI-FI COLOUR DESION

Brian Miller is a painter, comic book colorist, Arizona local, and founder of Hi-Fi colour design. Hi-Fi colors comic books for DC, Image, Marvel and other publishers. They also work with video game, animation, toy and clothing companies on designs, licensed art, and packaging.

MARAT MYCHAELS

When Mychaels was 13, he met fellow aspiring artist Rob Liefeld, who was 16 at the time, at a local comic book convention. The two struck up a friendship and kept in touch. Years later, Liefeld was working on New Mutants when he hired Mychaels as his assistant. Soon, Liefeld offered Mychaels Brigade. Mychaels' credits include Demonslayer, Knightmare, Battlestone, Nash and X-Force: Shatterstar.

TODD NAUCK

Todd Nauck regularly draws super heroes for the big two comic book companies: DC Comics and Marvel Comics. His 12 years' worth of credits include work on Friendly Neighborhood Spider-Man, Teen Titans Go, Superman, Young Justice, Teen Titans, 52 and countless others. He also writes and draws his own title, WildGuard (through Image Comics), which has been featured in TV Guide and Wizard Magazine.

NOEL NEILL

Noel is known as the original "Lois Lane" for acting in the 1948 and 1950 Superman movie serials opposite the screen's first Superman, Kirk Alyn, and later on TV with George Reeves. Her career came full circle with her portrayal of Getrude Vanderworth in 2006's Superman Returns opposite Kevin Spacey as Lex Luthor. She is currently promoting her biography, Truth, Justice, & The American Way: The Life & Times of Noel Neill, The Original Lois Lane.

Rob Osborne is the writer-artist of the award-winning graphic novel 1000 Steps to World Domination. Osborne also authored the critically-acclaimed graphic novella Sunset City: For Active Senior Living. He has worked as a writer, editorial cartoonist, graphic designer and illustrator, and as readers of 1000 Steps know, he aspires to conquer the world.

JAMES OWEN

James A. Owen wrote and illustrated the book Here, There Be Dragons, which is being developed as a feature film by Warner Brothers Studio. He has written and illustrated two dozen Starchild comics, the Mythworld series of novels (published in Germany and France) and more.

TONY PARKER

Tony has been in over 100 RPG books and magazines, 130 CCG cards, as well as indie comics and book covers. He has worked on many internationally-known and award-winning properties, including Conan, Warhammer, Mutants & Masterminds and Robert Heinlein's Starship Troopers.

GEORGE PEREZ

George's work on the Fantastic Four, The Inhumans and The Avengers garnered him the reputation as the artist who liked to draw group books. During his historic career, George has worked for every major publisher as well as some minor ones. He is best known for his work on The New Teen Titans, a series that helped turn DC Comics around in the early '80s and was also the first mainstream title to offer a royalties program to its creators. He is also well-known for his runs on Wonder Woman and for the maxi-series to end all maxi series. Crisis on Infinite Farths.

JEN LEE QUICK

Her published comic work includes: Soul Union, published in I.C. Entertainment's anthology Amerimanga; Once in a Blue Moon, published by Oni Press; and Off*Beat, published by Tokyopop, which won a silver medal for graphic novels in 2005's Foreward Magazine Book of the Year Awards.

TONE PODRIGUEZ

Back in 1999, Tone received a Russ Manning Award Nomination for Violent Messiahs from Image Comics. Tone followed with Violent Messiahs: Lamenting Pain. John Carpenter's Snake Plissken Chronicles followed as well as a job on The Simpsons' annual adventure Tree House of Horrors. Last year, The Covenant graphic novel, published by Top Cow, was developed into a motion picture for 20th Century Fox.

STEVE DUDE

Nexus, an offbeat science fiction superhero written and co-created with Mike Baron, remains Steve's most sustained and best-known work to date. Steve won the Russ Manning Newcomer Award and two Will Eisner Awards for Artistic Excellence. His most recent works include his new series, Steve Rude's The Moth, currently published by Dark Horse.

MIKE STACKPOLE

Michael A. Stackpole is an award-winning, New York Times Bestselling author, editor, game and computer game designer. In 1988 the first two of his novels appeared, and by 2005 he had 37 published books, including eight New York Times Bestselling Star Wars® novels.

ARTHUR GUYDAM

Arthur Suydam is a comic creator whose work was recently featured on covers for Marvel Zombies, Ghost Rider, Hellstorm and Wolverine: Origins, as well as the much-anticipated crossover of Marvel Zombies vs. Army of Darkness. Suydam's artwork and writing have been featured in publications including Heavy Metal and National Lampoon, as well as international sci-fi and comic anthologies.

JOE AND TIM VIOIL

The Vigil brothers are renowned horror and fantasy creators of the famous (or infamous) adult horror comic book Faust. They have also worked on Chaingang; My Dead Dog, Bobby, with author Joe R. Landsdale; and Joe's own, very personal comicbook, Dog, which is based on his unpublished novel.

IEN WEIN

Wein and artist Bernie Wrightson created the horror character *Swamp Thing*. In the early 1970s, Len began writing regularly for Marvel Comics. Wein had lengthy runs on *Marvel Team-Up*, *The Amazing Spider-Man*, *The Incredible Hulk*, *The Mighty Thor* and *Fantastic Four*. In 1975, he and artist Dave Cockrum revived the Stan Lee / Jack Kirby mutant-superhero team *The X-Men* after a half-decade's hiatus, reformatting the membership. Among the characters the duo created were Night-crawler, Storm, Colossus, and Thunderbird; Wein had previously created Wolverine, with artists John Romita Sr. and Herb Trimpe, in *The Incredible Hulk*. Wein plotted the next two X-Men stories with artist Cockrum.

DAN WICKLINE

Dan co-wrote 30 Days of Night: Dead Space with series creator Steve Niles, and (alone) wrote the current series 30 Days of Night: Spreading the Disease. In March, the Hero Initiative's charity graphic novel The Unusual Suspects will be published by Top Cow.

IIN WORKMAN

Lin is one half of Pencil Neck Studios. He and David Beaty are both currently working on the comic book series Bushi Tales. He was president of the Mid-South Cartoonists Association for over four years, but prefers his current role as vice president.


