

CONVENTION POLICIES



Admission

Admission is non-refundable.

By purchasing badges to SMDTEJ-COJ, attendees agree to allow photographs and/or video with their likeness to be used by SMDTEJ-COJ for promotional purposes, including (but not limited to): fliers, television commercials, print ads, or website advertisements.

Animals

Service animals will be allowed in the convention to assist those people who are in need of them. Other animals are not permitted in the convention space.

Badges

Badges must be worn and visible at all times. Individuals without badges will not be allowed in convention space.

No replacement will be provided for lost badges; a new membership must be purchased at the full rate. For this reason, keep a close eye on your badge. Please return any found badges to Registration.

Belongings

shorel-col is not liable for any missing belongings. Please keep a close eye on your items. If you lose something, please check the Lost and Found at the Information Desk

Children

Children ten and under must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

Convention Behavior

The following behaviors are not allowed at the convention:

- Disruptive or unsafe behavior that disturbs the staff or attendees
- Sleeping in convention space
- Physical or verbal harassment of staff or other attendees
- Destruction or defacement of hotel or convention property
- Sexual misconduct, such as indecent exposure, offensive touching, or sexual harassment
- Unwanted touching without permission of the individual, such as glomping, hugging, etc.
- Any activity prohibited by law

Individuals who violate these rules will be warned and asked to stop. SABOTED-COA reserves the right to request anyone violating these rules to leave the convention. If the person continues to violate these rules, they may be barred re-entry to the convention. Any violation of these rules which involves activities prohibited by law will result in notification of authorities.

Please behave respectfully in the hotel space and take care not to disturb non-convention hotel guests. We would like to leave a good impression with the hotel and its patrons. Convention attendes who are found disturbing other hotel guests in convention space, outside the hotel, or in hotel hallways are subject to disciplinary action, including being ejected from the convention.

Costumes

Above all, SMOTEL-COL is a family-friendly event. Please exercise modesty when wearing your costume as we have children in attendance. If the SMOTEL-COL staff feels your costume is too revealing, we may ask you to change your

costume. Excessive blood on a costume may also be upsetting to children.

Again, MBOTEL-COL staff may ask you to change your costume if we feel it is in poor taste.

All cosplayers must have a clear line of sight while wearing their costumes. If your costume has pieces that extend from it (spikes, armor, wings, etc.), please be careful of the other attendees. Please stay aware of your surroundings. If you damage or destroy any of the hotel property, you will be held responsible. Please do not block any doorways or exits with your costume or costume pieces. Anyone doing so may be asked to return their costume to their room.

Shoes are required to be worn while in the convention space. However, you may remove your shoes for photos if desired, but they must be replaced directly after the photo is taken.

Performance of skits in the hallways will not be permitted.

Curfew

City of Mesa enforces a curfew for minors. Curfew for minors under sixteen is 10:00 pm; curfew for minors 16-17 is 12:00 am. Liability for curfew violations in on the parent, so please make sure your children are not violating curfew. If this is an issue for you, we recommend renting a hotel room for those evenings. Programming will run well into the morning hours, so please plan accordingly.

Dancing

We all love to dance, but this behavior can be disruptive to vendors, staff, and other attendees. If you and your friends would like to perform dances (such as the "Hare Hare Yukai".

"Caramelldansen", or a Conga line), please do this outside and out of the way of other attendees. If the dance interferes with other activities, Security will be called to stop the dancing. You

are welcome to dance, but make sure it is in an empty area and does not interfere with others.

Dancing by attendees is not allowed in the Vendor Hall at any time due to space constraints.

Eating Contests

Attendees who participate in any convention-organized eating contests (such as ramen-eating contest) acknowledges that there are risks of personal injury, illness, and possible loss of life, and risks of damage to or loss of personal property, which may result from participating in such contests.

By voluntarily participating in such contests, the attendee agrees to not hold MOTEL-CON liable for acts or omissions arising out of or related to the contest or the attendee's participation in the contest.

Fliers

One table near Registration will be set aside for fliers. There is no charge to place fliers on this table. Please be considerate and limit your fliers to a single pile. Also, do not remove other fliers or cover them up. Fliers may not contain adult or illegal material. Fliers remaining at the end of the convention will be thrown out or recycled—if you wish to save your fliers please pick them up before 5:00 pm on Monday, November 1, 2009.

Fliers left elsewhere in the convention (such as in panel rooms, at events, stuck on walls) will be thrown out immediately. Excessive amounts of fliers will result in all fliers from that organization being removed from the convention.

Music

Music played via instrument or boom box can be considered disruptive behavior. If you would like to share music with others, please do so at a reasonable volume and away from other convention activities. It is allowed to carry a boom box or musical device as long as the volume is acceptable. If it is deemed to be too loud, you may be asked to turn it down or off completely. If your music is particularly fun and causes dancing, the dancing must follow the "Dancing" policy above.

Photography

When taking a picture of a cosplayer, please be conscious of traffic in the hallways or Vendors Hall. Please take the pictures off to the side so you do not block traffic.

Please be considerate and ask before taking pictures of other attendees, staff, or guests.

Signs

The construction and display of signs by attendees is not allowed. This includes such signs as "Free Hugs", "Will Yuri for Yaoi", or "Glomps for Cash". Attendees carrying such signage will be warned and have the sign confiscated.

SINDIGA-COA) staff reserves the right to eject attendees carrying such signs from the convention and bar re-entry. The only exception to this rule is signs that are part of a costume (such as Phoenix Wright carrying an "Objection!" sign) are allowed.

Please do not post any signs on the walls. Hotel policy prohibits us from posting anything on the walls (such as posters, banners, pictures, etc.). Anything posted on the walls will be taken down and thrown away.

Staff

Please be courteous to all convention staff. We are all unpaid and work very hard to deliver a quality convention. If you have an issue you would like addressed, please contact a staff member and we will do our best to fairly settle the issue for you.

Weapons

Permitted weapons/props:

- Staves, bo sticks, boken, shinai, and wooden swords are permitted.
- All fake, prop, or homemade weapons are permitted if they are in no way dangerous to attendees.

 Mbottal-coal staff will determine on a case-by-case basis whether a fake, prop or homemade weapon is dangerous. Staff decisions will be final.

Attendees are required to have all such weapons peace bonded by MOTEN-CON security before entering convention facilities. There will be a peace bonding station located near Registration.

A weapon/prop requires peace bonding if:

- A person could think it is a genuine weapon from 10 feet away.
- A person could reasonably conclude that the item may cause physical harm or damage to property.

All weapons deemed unsafe for the convention by MADIGLACOL security must be removed from the convention and stored in private quarters (car, home, hotel room). The skill or lack of skill of the person in possession of a prop weapon is irrelevant to the determination of whether or not it is dangerous.

Misuse of any prop weapon, such as swinging it in a public area or causing hazards to others will result in the weapon or prop being deemed unsafe for the convention

Prohibited weapons:

- Live steel is not permitted unless the item can be secured in its sheath by ℠ℴℸℴℴℴℴℴ security and it is not removed during the convention. Live steel is defined as swords, knives, or other objects made of metal, which can take an edge.
- Guns and projectile weapons are prohibited at ™orEi-Coil. Examples of guns and projectile weapons include, but are not limited to, live guns, pellet guns, BB guns, air guns, crossbows, dart guns, and blowguns. Replicas of live guns are permitted if they are easily identifiable as props.
- Nunchaku and other projectile weapons are prohibited.
- Incendiary devices are not permitted. All devices which spark, shoot flame, burn, smolder, can otherwise self-initiate combustion, or which exist for no purpose other than to be lit with a combustion device, are considered incendiary devices.


Illegal weapons are prohibited at MOTOLcol. Attendees found to be carrying illegal weapons will be immediately reported to appropriate authorities.

 Concealed weapons are prohibited.
 All prop weapons must be carried in plain view and cannot be concealed.

Vendor Hall purchases:

- Any prohibited weapons purchased at SMOTEN-CON must be securely packaged and immediately removed from the convention center. Weapons should be stored in attendees' private quarters and are not to be taken out of their packaging or wrapping at any time on convention premises.
- All prop weapons purchased at the convention must be peace bonded by Moreu-col security if they are to be carried during the convention

Saboten-con staff reserves the right to revoke your badge and eject anyone at anytime from the convention withour a refund.'



Steve Blum

With literally hundreds of voice-over credits to his name, VO-veteran Steve Blum is best known as the voice of Spike Spiegel from Cowboy Bebop, Wolverine from several incarnations of X-Men (animated movies, games, the Wolverine and the X-Men TV Series and the upcoming Super Hero Squad), Tom (the robot) from Toonami, Green Goblin from the Spectacular Spiderman series, Heatblast, Vilgax and Ghostfreak from Ben 10, the voice of 7-11, Guilmon and dozens of other characters from 3 seasons of Digimon, Zabuza and Orochimaru from Naruto, Roger Smith from The Big O. Kazuma from S-cry-ed, Jamie from Megas XLR. Vincent Valentine from Final Fantasy VII: Advent Children and Dirge of Cerberus, Blunk from Disney's W.I.T.C.H, Ares in God of War, Yakky Doodle from Harvey Birdman, Leeron from Gurren Lagann and multiple characters from Wolf's Rain, Blood +, Billy and Mandy, Scooby Doo, Afro Samurai, Lilo and Stitch, Star Wars, and many, many others.

Chuck Huber

Born May 8th, 1971 in Chicago, Illinois, actor Chuck Huber has experience in stage, voice, and regular acting. He graduated in 1994 from DePaul University in Chicago at age 23 with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Theatre Studies. Chuck is best known for his roles as Shou Tucker in Fullmetal Alchemist, Hiei in YuYu Hakusho, Hiro Nohara in Shin Chan, and Reever Wenham in D.Gray-Man. Vic has been acting for stage and screen since he was 8 years old, but he started his career in anime about ten years ago as Vega in Streetfighter II. Since then, Vic has been in more than a hundred shows. known for such roles as Edward Elric in Fullmetal Alchemist. Tamaki Suou in Ouran High School Host Club, Fai in Tsubasa Chronicle, Ikkaku in Bleach, Yukito in Air, Takanaga in Wallflower, Dark in DN Angel, Kurz in Full Metal Panic, Broly in Dragonball Z, Kougaijji in Saiyuki, Tatsu in Peacemaker, Virgil Walsh in Trinity Blood, Hikaru in Macross, and many more. Vic has also voiced roles in a large number of video games including Soul Calibur, Disgaea, Persona III, Project Sylpheed, and more.

But even longer than his voice acting, Vic has been a professional music composer / singer / producer who has written and produced hundreds of songs for TV, radio, and CD. He sings the themes for shows like **One Piece & DBGT**, and has produced several CDs of his own original music.

In addition to anime and music, Vic has a degree in film and works regularly writing, producing, and directing video and film productions.

Her intricate and lavish creations have won awards and acclaim nationwide; she has taught a multitude of panels on costume craftsmanship, presentation, makeup, wigs and more; and judged countless costume contests.

In addition to drawing, M. Alice is an avid costume designer, jewelry maker, and cosplayer. Her designs have won awards across the country, and have been featured in *Newtype*, *Gothic and Lolita Bible*, and other printed media. M. Alice frequently acts as a celebrity judge at conventions and hosts workshops on cosplay construction, cosmetics and presentation, in addition to drawing and comics industry panels. Her favorite color is pink and her favorite ninja turtle is Donatello.
