- The park opens at 10:00am and closes at 6:00pm every day. No entry into Old Tucson after 5:00pm*.
- The Old Tucson entrance closes at 8:00pm Friday and Saturday. No admittance after 8:00pm and no refunds for late arrival.

Guests may be removed from the premises for violations of these rules, OT rules or WWWC rules without compensation or refund.
Security personnel from WWWC5 and OT have the authority to enforce all rules.

* Attendees with concert tickets and a valid wristband may stay in the park after 6:00pm as you are not required to leave when the park closes. If wristband is lost you will be required to pay a wristband replacement fee.
