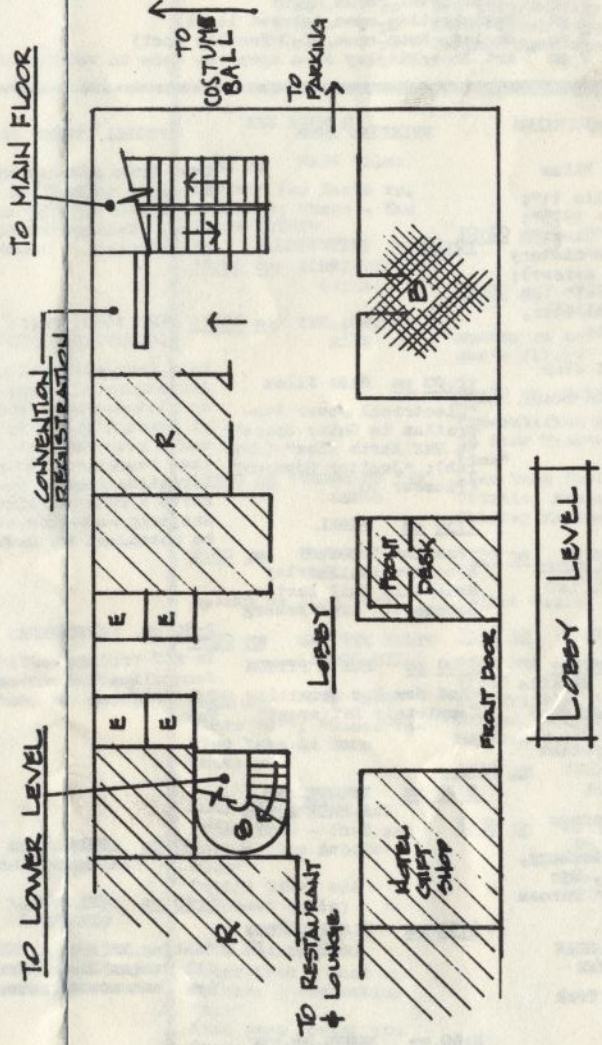
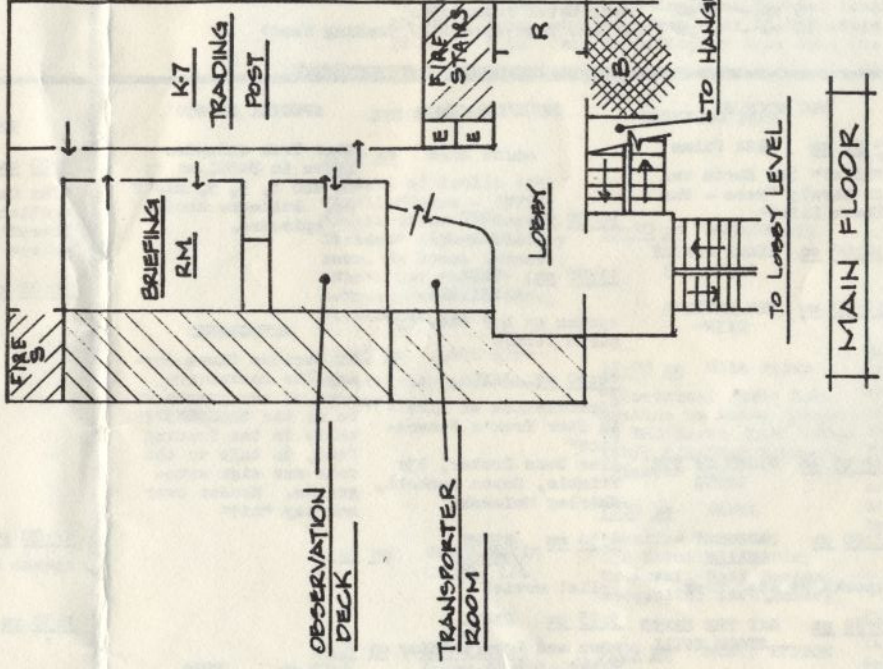
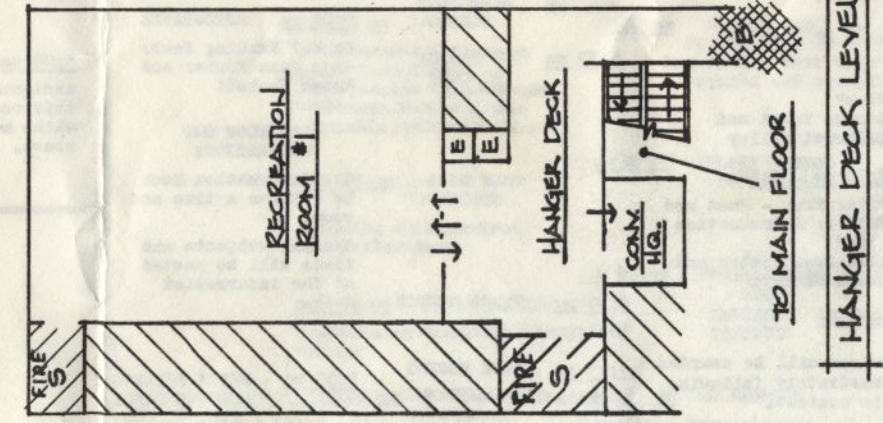
PHOENIX FAN CONVENTION

CONVENTION RULES

1. All convention attendees must be wearing a convention badge to be admitted to the upstairs convention areas and to the costume dance. The lower levels only are open to the public and badges are not required.
2. Smoking is prohibited in all display rooms, the theaters, and the dealers room. Smoking will be permitted in designated lobby areas only.
3. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited from the convention areas.
4. Seating at all program events is on a first-come, first-served basis. No persons will be allowed to sit or stand in the aisles or doorways during any event.
5. The management of the Phoenix Fan Convention bears no responsibility for items lost, stolen, or damaged during the convention, or for physical injuries sustained during the convention. Photography is restricted to such times and places as designated by the convention. Recording or photographing any film item is prohibited by law.
7. Food and/or beverages will not be allowed in the theater areas.
8. Anyone behaving in a manner considered detrimental to the convention will be asked to leave the convention and will not be permitted to return.
9. Any violation of the above rules and regulations may constitute grounds for expulsion without refund from the convention.
